PROGRAM NOTE

Commissioned by the CBC Radio Orchestra for their Farewell Concert in 2008, *Requiem Fragments* memorializes one of the last great radio orchestras in North America, committed to commissioning, performing, and recording new works. The trajectory of the music embodies a sense of yearning for an idyllic past—a gathering of energy followed by a suspension of time. An anacrusis to a sustained tone, a melodic blossoming, and rupture are present on both micro and macro levels—as local gesture and also playing out over the course of the entire work.

Requiem Fragments may be heard as a requiem for lost innocence relating to expatriotism and questions of belonging, relating specifically to the immigrant or refugee experience. The piece was revised in 2010, and has a duration of seven minutes.
